
Thank you for choosing to be a Texas Mason. I am looking forward to working with you in 2021.



#### Ritual in our work



# Domicile Requirements for Candidates when Petitioning

We have recently had several young men express interest in becoming Masons. A couple of these men are members of the military. The Grand Lodge of Texas states that you must be domiciled in the Jurisdiction of the Grand Lodge and Lodge you are planning to join for at least 6 months prior to petitioning. Grand Lodge Law states that if you have resided in your jurisdiction for 6 months and because of business or education you must leave your jurisdiction but have intentions of returning to your domicile, your domicile is not given up or changed. These requirements are waived for all active-duty military members.




